Committee	MA/MS and PhDs are required to form committees. The committees are led by one or two (co-chairs) tenure-track faculty members. MA/MS are required to have three members. PhDs are required to have five members, and one must be from outside the department. Please note that the EXAM COMMITTEE and DISSERTATION COMMITTEE for PhDs does not need to be the same. Coursework	Students are required to complete 30 credits of "coursework" or classes. Thesis hours and dissertation hours are not included in this. For full-time PhD students, coursework is often completed after 4 semesters or 2 academic years. Once coursework is completed, students can begin the exam process to advance to candidacy.						
Dissertation	PhD Students/Candidates are required to complete a dissertation which must involve in-depth research. The PhD Candidate is guided by their chair and four additional committee members (4 total). One of these committee members must be from outside of the department.		Aubrey 1.14.25				
Exams	Once a student finishes coursework, they will create a reading list and work on their exams. The exams occur over a three month period and involve responding to three different questions. The reading list should be used to respond to these questions, and the questions will be related to the student's interest and provided by their committee. Once the written exams are complete, they are submitted to the committee and reviewed for approximately two weeks before an oral defense occurs. PhD Candidate	A PhD candidate is a student who has completed coursework requirements and passed any preliminary exams and is now moving toward the dissertation itself.
